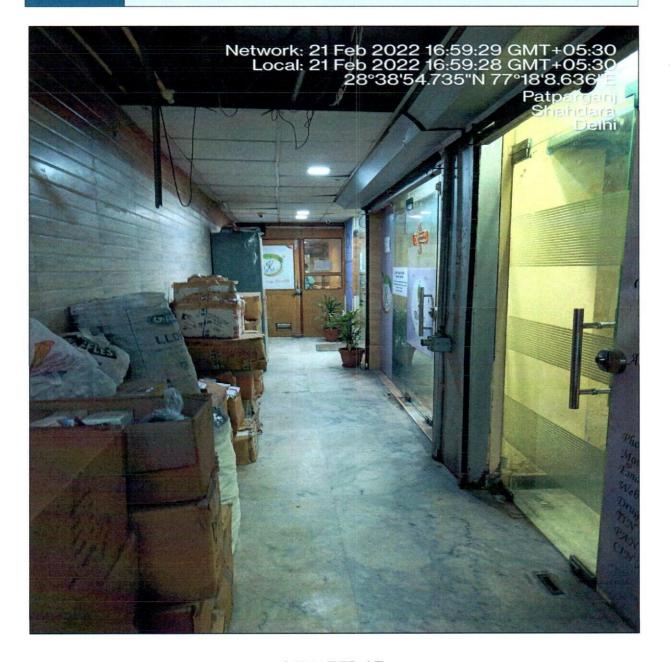

This opinion on Valuation is prepared for the commercial office unit situated at the aforesaid address having total super area admeasuring 56.53 sq.mtr. (608.48 sq.ft.) and carpet area admeasuring 40.77 sq.mtr. (438.90 sq.yds.) as per the sale Deed provided to us by the bank.

The Office unit has proportionate, undivided, indivisible and impartible ownership rights in the land having area measuring 6.46 sq. mtr. In the building known as Rishabh Corporate Tower which is a commercial tower in Karkardooma Community Centre.

As per the sale deed S. No. 8776, dated 20.08.2015, page No. 6, the property type is residential, however the property is used for commercial purposes and the stamp duty is paid as per the commercial use of the unit.

Integrity and Fairness

- 1. A valuer shall, in the conduct of his/its business, follow high standards of integrity and fairness in all his/its dealings with his/its clients and other valuers.

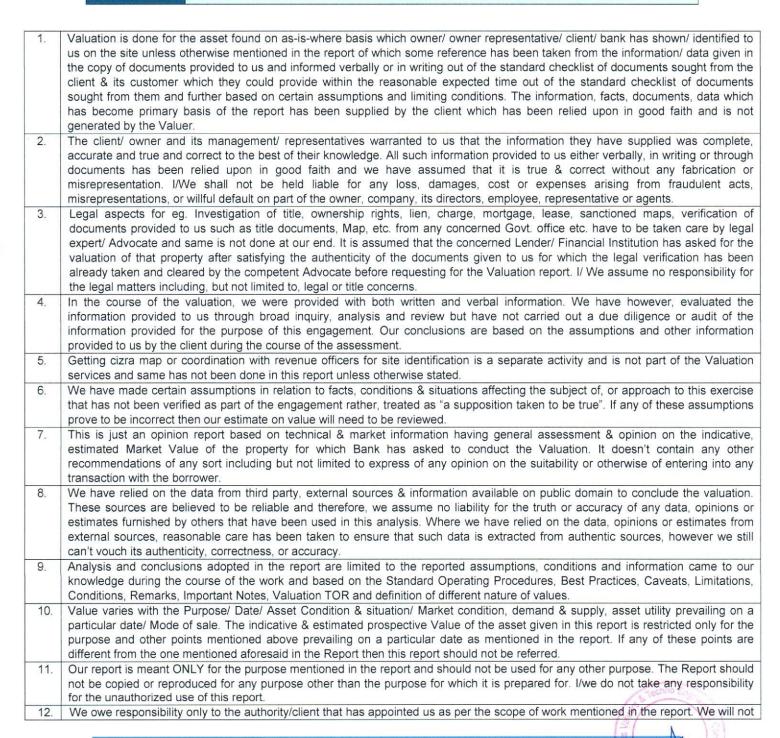

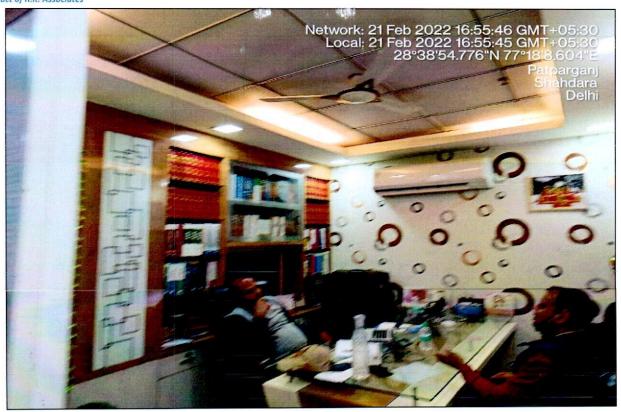
