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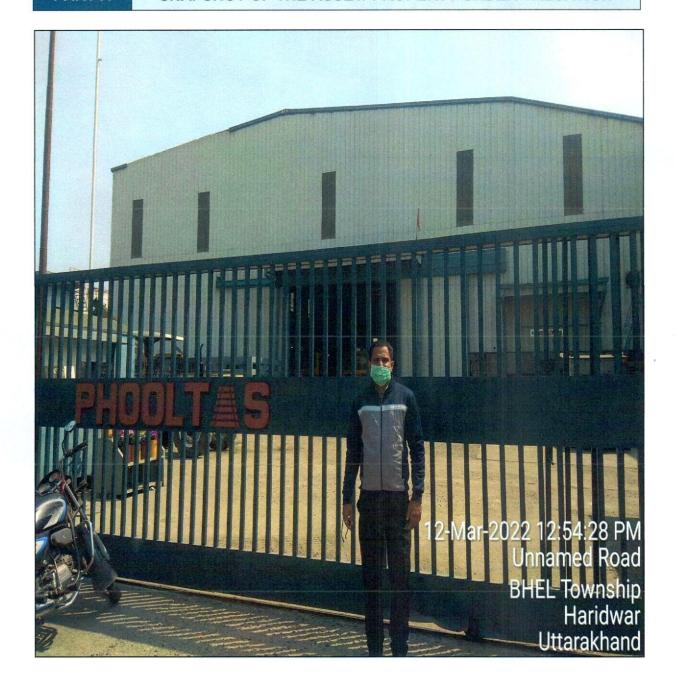

5. The subject property is an industrial property situated at aforesaid address having total land measuring 18,375 sg.mtr/21,976.31 sg.yds as per the Lease deed provided to us by the bank.

Further as per the copy of order of NCLT, a petition was filed under for the demerger of business in between M/s. Speed Craft limited (Demerger Company) and Phooltas Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (Resulting Company) and further NCLT has passed a order for the demerger of business where M/s. Speed Craft has got Roads Business along with 9207.625 sq.mtr. of land at the aforesaid address and M/s. Phooltas Technologies Pvt. Ltd. has got Rail Business along with 9168.375 sq.mtr. land at the aforesaid address.

This Valuation report has been prepared for the property having total land area admeasuring 9168.375 sq.mtr. along with civil structures lying at the site.

At present no separate municipality plot number has been provided however NCLT has passed order for the same, as informed during site visit. Therefore, the bank is advised to take a legal opinion before taking any financial decision.

This is a lease hold property & lease deed executed on 03-03-2006 for the period of 90 years.

The covered area of the subject portion of land has taken on the basis of site measurement done by our engineer at the site. The building consist of 2 Tin shed structure mounted on a brick wall.

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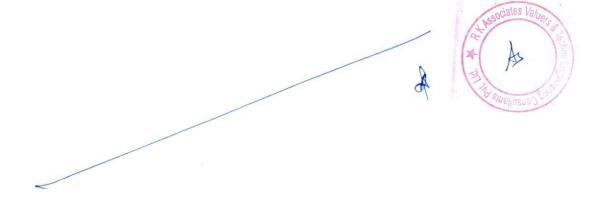

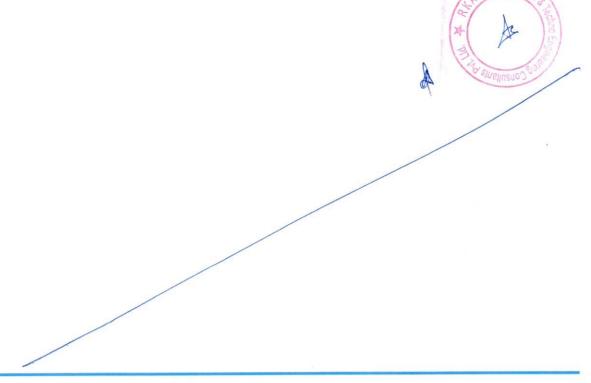

- Analysis and conclusions adopted in the report are limited to the reported assumptions, conditions and information came to our knowledge during the course of the work and based on the Standard Operating Procedures, Best Practices, Caveats, Limitations, Conditions, Remarks, Important Notes, Valuation TOR and definition of different nature of values.

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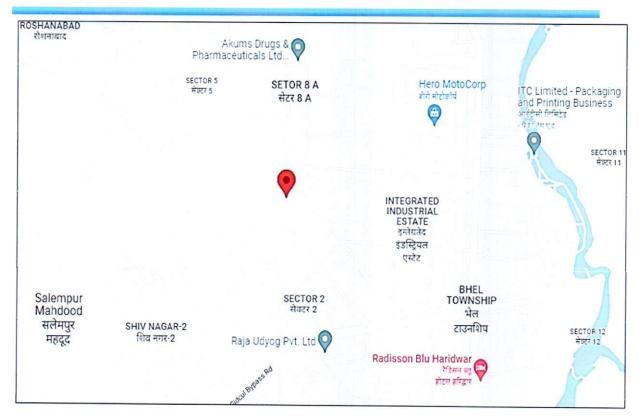

Integrity and Fairness

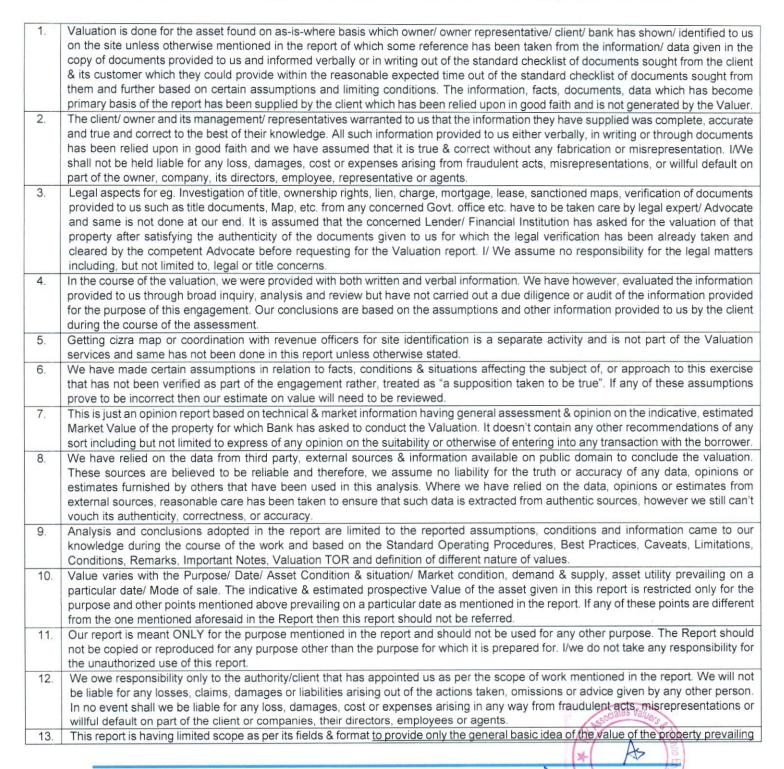

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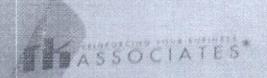
