CONSENT is hereby granted under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and the Rules and Orders made thereunder to

M/s. Siddharth Material Handling Pvt.Ltd., Plot No. R-667,
T.T.C. Industrial Area, Thane-Belapur Road, Thane.

(hereinafter referred to as "the Applicant") authorising them to operate their industrial plants in the Air Pollution Control Area as notified, subject to the conditions, stated below :

(1) This Consent is valid upto 31.8.2009

(2) The applicant shall take immediate action to install or modify the equipments for the control of emission level of pollutants to the satisfaction of the Board. This shall be done prior to the date noted against each item :

- (13) The applicant shall furnish to the Board and/or its visiting officer any information regarding the construction, installation, operation of pollution control systems and such other particulars as may be pertinent for preventing and controlling pollution of air and noise.
- (14) If due to any technological improvement or otherwise, this Board is of the opinion that all or any of the conditions referred above require variation (including the change of any control equipment either in whole or in part), this Board shall after giving the applicant an opportunity of being heard vary all or any of such conditions, and thereupon the applicant shall be bound to comply with the condition so varied.
- (15) The applicant shall comply with and carry out directives/orders issued by the Board in this consent order and at subsequent times without any negligence on his part. The applicant shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provisions of the Law/Act in case of noncompliance of any order/directive issued by the Board or its concerned offices at any time and/or violation of the terms and conditions of this consent order.
- (16) The liquid effluent arising out of the operation of the air pollution control equipment shall be treated in manner and to the standards stipulated in the consent granted by this Board under the provisions of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and its subsequent amendments.
- (17) The firm shall obtain authorisation from the Board for handling and disposal of Hazardous waste under the provision of sections 6, 8 and 25 of Environment (Protection) Act, (EPA) 1986 and the rules made thereunder.
- (18) **SOLID WASTE :** The solid waste arising in the factory premises as sweepings, empty containers residues, sludges, including those from control equipment ect. shall be disposed of carefully by composting, Land filling, sale etc, so as not to cause damage to environment.
- (19) The firm shall submit to this office, the 15th day of May every year, the Environmental Audit Report for the financial year ending 31st March in the prescribed Form V as per the Provisions of rule 14 of the Environment (Protection) Second Amendment Rules 1992,
- (20) An inspection book shall be opened and made available to the Board's officers during their visit to the factory.
