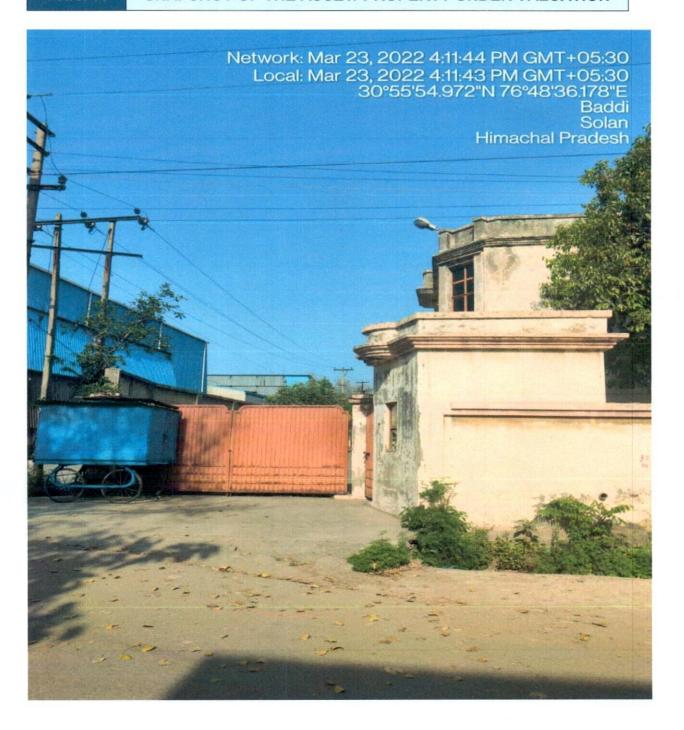

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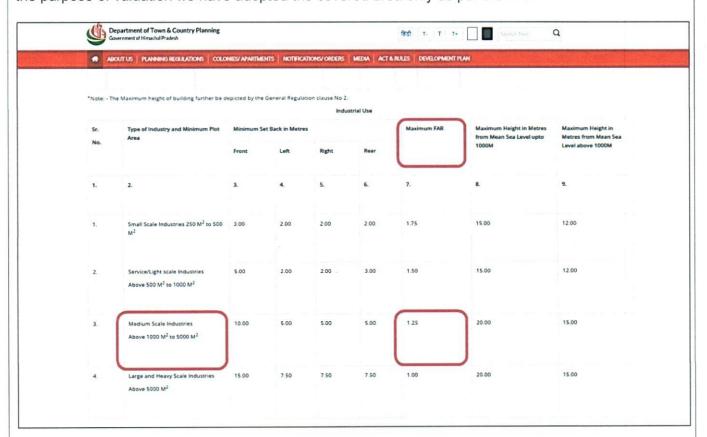


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Brief description of the property

This opinion on valuation is prepared for the industrial property situated at the aforesaid address having total land area admeasuring 1996 sq.mtr. (2387.19 sq.yds.) and it has a covered area of building 1 with RCC having ~22,400 sq. ft. and of building 2 with RCC covered area of ~5,800 sq ft.

However, the total constructed area is exceeding the permissible FAR of that same area. Total land area is 1996 sq.mtr. and as per building by laws the permissible constructed area should be 2,495 sq.mtr. (26,855 sq.ft.) but total constructed area found at site is 2,619 sq.mtr. (28,200 sq.ft.). so for the purpose of valuation we have adopted the covered area only as per the FAR.



All the details pertaining to the building area statement such as area, floor, etc has been taken from the old valuation report provided by the bank since no other relevant building area statement has been provided to us by the bank or client since our surveyor was not allowed to take sample measurement.

It is located at Plot No.-234, HPSIDC, Industrial Area, Baddi, Tehsil- Nalagarh, and District-Solan, Himachal Pradesh. At the time of survey the industry was vacant and no work was ongoing and as per the representative it's closed for around 12 years and is around 500 mtr. away from Solan Road which is ~20 mtr. width. Location of the subject property is in a good industrial area.

In case of discrepancy in the address mentioned in the property documents and the property shown to us at the site due to change in zoning or administrative level at the site or client misled the valuer by providing the fabricated document, the valuation should be considered of the property shown to us at the site of which the photographs are also attached. Our responsibility will be only related to the valuation of the property shown to us on the site and not regarding matching from the documents or searching the property from our own. Banker to verify from district administration/ tehsil level the identification of the

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property if it is the same matching with the document pledged.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. No legal aspects in terms of ownership or any other legal aspect is taken into consideration. Even if any such information is mentioned in the report it is only referred from the information provided for which we do not assume any responsibility. Due care has been given while doing valuation assessment but it doesn't contain any due-diligence or audit or verification of any kind other than the valuation computation of the property shown to us on site. Information/ data/ documents given to us by Bank/ client have been relied upon in good faith. This report doesn't contain any other recommendations of any sort.
