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Brief description of the property

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the property situated at the aforesaid address. As per the copy of sale the ownership of the land belongs to Mrs. Poonam. Total land area of the property as per the copy of sale deed is 260.12 sq.mtr / 311 sq.yds. and the same has been verified through our physical measurement during the time of our site visit.

The subject property is residential house with G+2 floor structure built on it. As per the copy of approved map provided to us by the bank the sanctioned approved map is only for G+1 floor structure therefore for our valuation assessment we have not considered the area built on the 2nd floor of the subject property. The subject property is situated at internal road of Green Park which further connects it to Saharanpur Road. All the basic and civic amenities is present in the nearby locality.

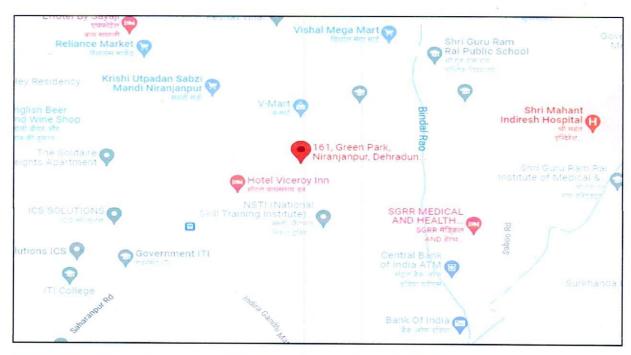
