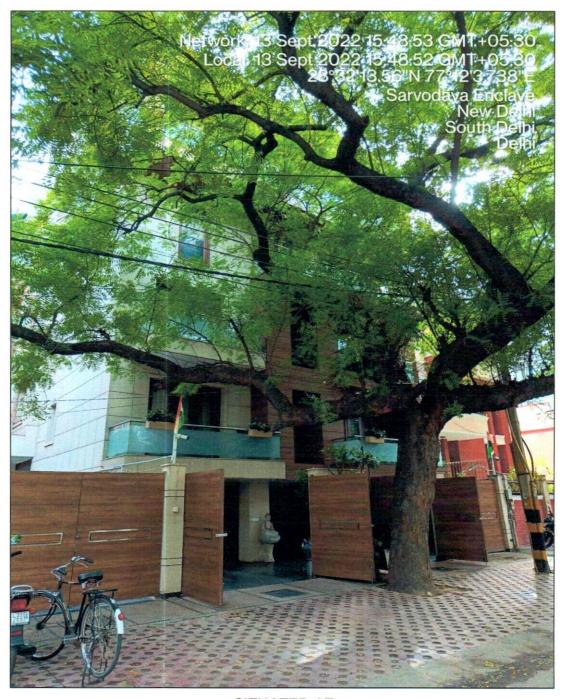

Brief description of the property

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the independent builder floor situated at the aforesaid address having total covered area 234 sq.mt. (~2518 sq.ft) as per the sale deed provided to us by the client.

The said property is located on the third floor of a S+G+3 floor building. As per the document the building is a B+S+G+3 floor building. However as per site survey observation no basement was found in the building.

As per the documents provided to us by the client, the entire 3rd floor with a layout of 4 bedrooms with attached toilets, one kitchen, one drawing cum dining room, one store room purchased by vendee including a part of terrace above 3rd floor, measuring 1620 sq. ft. and a car parking spot in the stilt area measuring ~ 392.5 sq. ft.

The property is currently vacant at the time of site survey. But the caretaker of the property who was also the representative of the owner at the time of survey, staying in servant room which is constructed on Terrace floor. As per his information the owners of the property visits oftenly.

The subject property is located in B-112, Sarvodaya Enclave, New Delhi and is around 300 mtr. far from Sri Aurobindo Marg.

Most of the civic amenities are available in close vicinity. The surrounding location is well developed for residential purpose.

In case of discrepancy in the address mentioned in the property documents and the property shown to us at the site due to change in zoning or administrative level at the site or client misled the valuer by providing the fabricated document, the valuation should be considered of the property shown to us at the site of which the photographs are also attached. Our responsibility will be only related to the valuation of the property shown to us on the site and not regarding matching from the documents or searching the property from our own. Banker to verify from district administration/ tehsil level the identification of the property if it is the same matching with the document pledged.
