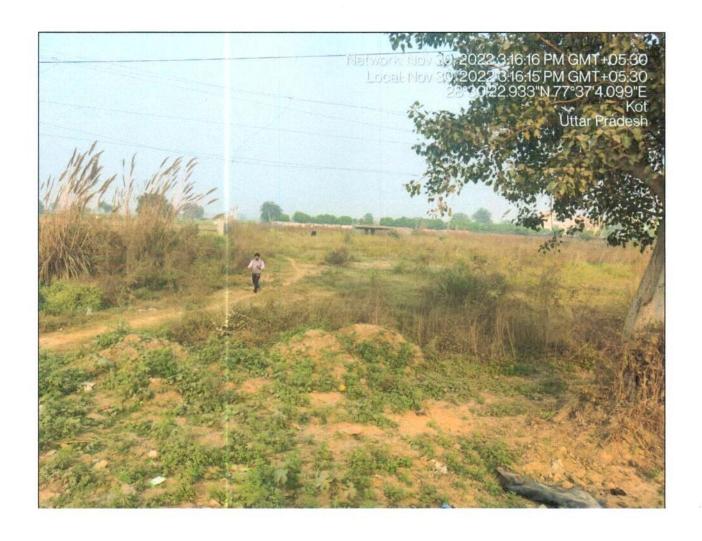

Also, it has also been observed that the boundary wall is passing in between the subject land if it is compared by the snapshot of the demarcated land provided by the client, the same is attached in the annexure below. 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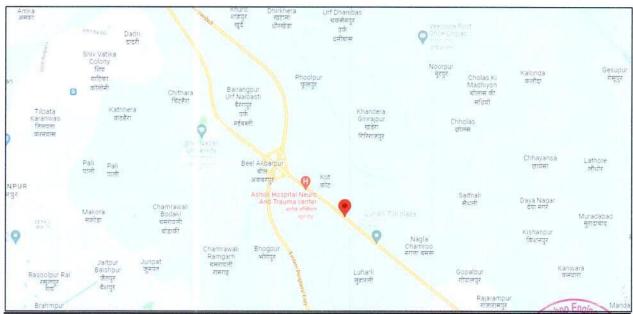
