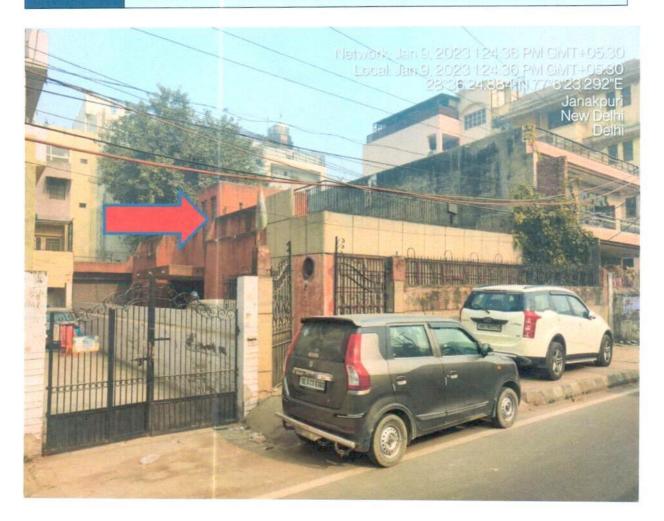

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the residential property having a total land area of 351sq.mtr. /419 sq.yds. as per the copy of documents provided and site measurement.

The subject property is a residential house having a total built-up area of 196.2 sq.mtr. / 2112 sq.ft. as per site measurement. As per information provided on site the subject property was built in ~1980 and has been locked for ~25 years.

It's located in good residential area of Janakpuri and is abutted by Pankha Road which is ~60 feet wide. All the major amenities are available in close vicinity of the property.

In case of discrepancy in the address mentioned in the property documents and the property shown to us at the site due to change in zoning or administrative level at the site or client misled the valuer by providing the fabricated document, the valuation should be considered of the property shown to us at the site of which the photographs are also attached. Our responsibility will be only related to the valuation of the property shown to us on the site and not regarding matching from the documents or searching the property from our own. Banker to verify from district administration/ tehsil level the identification of the property if it is the same matching with the document pledged.

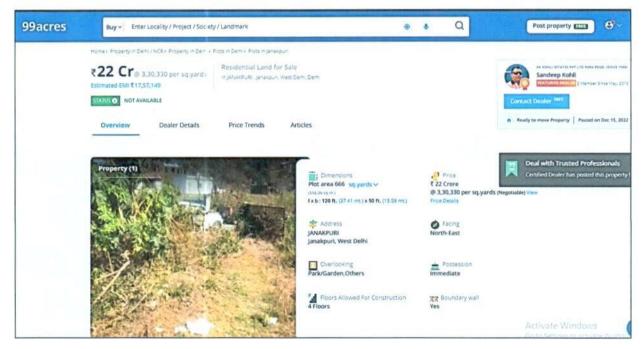

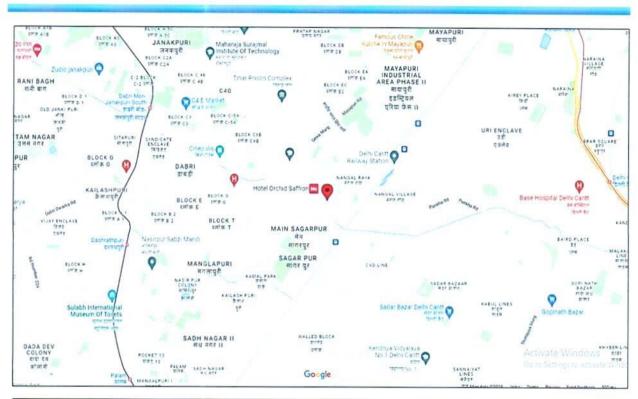
