CHARACTERISTICS DESCRIPTION OF THE ASSET

1. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This valuation report is prepared for the Heliport at Tourism Facilitation Centre (TFC), Ayodhya and having a total area of 3897.55 sq.mtr/0.96 Acre as per the measurement done by the surveyor with the help of satellite measuring tool during the physical site inspection. The final scope of work of this report is only Valuation of the property as confirmed over email dated: 07/06/2023



As per the information provided by the representative of UP Tourism, the Tourism Facilitation Centre (TFC) includes Rani Ho Park, Shelter Home, Shilp Gram, Hatt and Heliport. However, this report includes the valuation of Heliport only. We have not been provided any property relevant document from the client side. However the department of Tourism allowed us through Email dated 25/05/2023 to carry out the valuation of the subject properties based on the measurement of properties done by the Google satellite & Sample measurement at site.

The Heliport covered area on the ground is 297 sq.mtr which have been considered for this valuation report. The main road to reach the subject property is Ayodhya Bypass Road \sim 80 feet wide and the approach road is Ram Katha Park Road which is \sim 40 feet wide. The nearby locality is a developing residential and commercial area. The land mark for the subject property is Naya Ghat.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. No legal aspects in terms of ownership or any other legal aspect is taken into consideration. Even if any such information is mentioned in the report it is only referred from the information provided for which we do not assume any responsibility. Due care has been given while doing valuation assessment, but it doesn't contain any due-diligence or audit or verification of any kind other than the valuation computation of the property shown to us on site. Information/ data/ documents given to us by Bank/ client have been relied upon in good faith. This report doesn't contain

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any other recommendations of any sort.

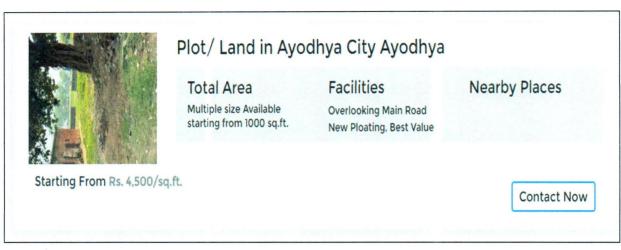

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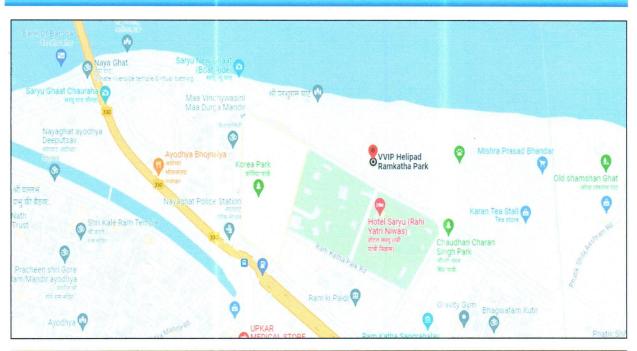

1.
