### 2. PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PROPERTY

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the Industrial property situated at the aforesaid address. As per the documents provided the subject property admeasuring total land area of 2427.77 sq. yds. And lies in the Industrial Area of Faridabad, Haryana.

During the site survey the name displayed in the name plate of the property as Esko Casting and Electronics Private Limited, but as per the documents provided to us, the name is M/S. Esko Die Casting (P) Ltd. but any document regarding change of name of company is not provided to us.

The subject property comprises of both RCC and shed structure of G+2 floors. As approved map/ building sheet is not provided to calculate the built-up area, Therefore, total built up area has been taken according to the measurements carried out during site survey. The total built up area of R.C.C structures comes to be 9,475 sq. ft. and sheds area is 11,568 sq. ft. Details of which is furnished in attached detail building sheet.

The subject property is used for industrial purpose i.e., manufacturing of packing materials for their own products which is been manufactured at other location. The subject property is located in Faridabad industrial area and is situated at a distance of approx. 1 KM from National Highway named NH-1 from Srinagar to Kanyakumari, width of which is approx. 150 feet. All the basic and civic amenities are available within the close proximity of the subject property.

In case of discrepancy in the address mentioned in the property documents and the property shown to us at the site due to change in zoning or administrative level at the site or client misled the valuer by providing the fabricated document, the valuation should be considered of the property shown to us at the site of which the photographs are also attached. Our responsibility will be only related to the valuation of the property shown to us on the site and not regarding matching from the documents or searching the property from our own. In case

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required, Bank may further engage district administration/ tehsil level to verify the identification of the property if it is the same matching with the document pledged.


