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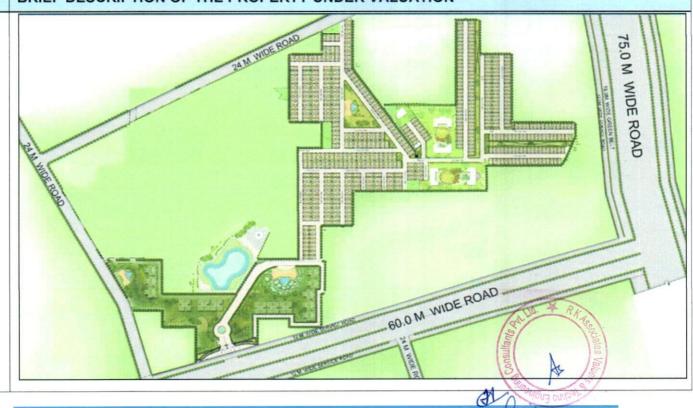

2. BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

a.



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This Project Tie Up Report is prepared for the Residential Group Housing project in the name of "Smart World Gems" being developed at the aforesaid address on land area of 57,508.41 sq.mtr./ 14.21 acres as per the RERA Certificate provided to us by the bank.

The Land for the subject Project was Granted License in the name of M/s Adhikaansh Realtors Pvt. Ltd. & M/s Aawam Residency Pvt. Ltd. for a total land parcel of 52.275 acres/ 2,11,549.397 sq.mtr.as per the copy of license Provided to us out of which the land area of 57508.41 sq.mtr./14.21 acres is issued under RERA certificate as separate Project named as "Smart World Gems" and the developer for the subject Project is M/s Adhikaansh Realtors Pvt. Ltd..

The subject Project Consist of 506 Residential Plots in total with each being developed in the configuration of B+G+4 floors, having total of 2024 Residential units in the whole project. The 281 Plots out of total Plots are freeze under the "Deen Dayal Jan Awas Yojna" which the promoter can only realize once the Development of the project reach 50% of the Progress as per the information provided by the Developer representative. As Per DDJAY APHP-2016 Allotment of 50% residential plots covering saleable area (excluding 50% area frozen by the Department) shall be undertaken in the first phase by the licencee/coloniser. However, the colonizer shall also carry out development works simultaneously on left area also. It is clarified that 15% area mortgaged towards IDW shall be part of 50% area frozen by Department upto completion of IDW in the colony.

All the Plots in the Project are under construction and only excavation and land development work was carried out as observed during the site survey.

All the consideration regarding the area and FAR of the subject Project is considered as per the RERA certificate as no separate map for the subject Project is provided to us.

All the Plots in the project are under construction as per observed and information during the site survey.







The subject project is located in midst of Developing area of Sector 89, Gurugram. The subcan be clearly approached from 80 ft. wide Sector Road and the main road to the subject Pataudi Road. Many Group housing Projects are being developed in the area.

ENCLOSURE: 3- GOOGLE MAP LOCATION





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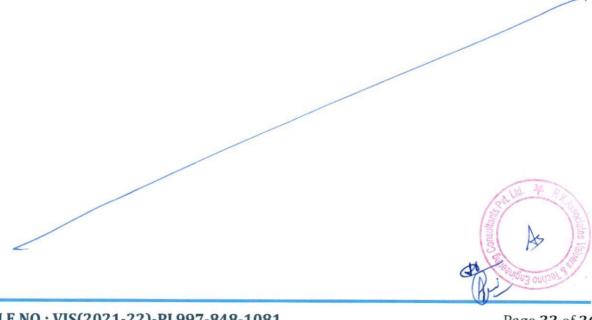
