7. Brief description of the property

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the residential property situated at the aforesaid address having total land area 117 sq.mtr. As per the approved map provided to us the road widening area is 14.91 sq. mtr and the total net area is 102.09 sq. mtr. and the same is considered for this valuation assessment.

As per the approved map the building is G+1 storied R.C.C. structure with total covered area 125.29 sq. mtr. but during site survey measurement the total covered area is 2543 sq. ft./236.25 sq.m. hence extra covered area of 110.96 Sq.m, is not considered for this valuation assessment.

The ground floor is comprises of 1 drawing room, 1 kitchen, 1 bedroom, 2 washroom and the first floor is 2 bedroom, 1 drawing room, 3 toilets.

The approach road of the subject property is Saraswati vihar road (20 ft)and approximately 1.5 km away from main road (Haridwar Byepass Road).

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. No legal aspects in terms of ownership or any other legal aspect is taken into consideration. Even if any such information is mentioned in the report it is only referred from the information provided for which we do not assume any responsibility. Due care has been given while doing valuation assessment, but it doesn't contain any due-diligence or audit or verification of any kind other than the valuation computation of the property shown to us on site. 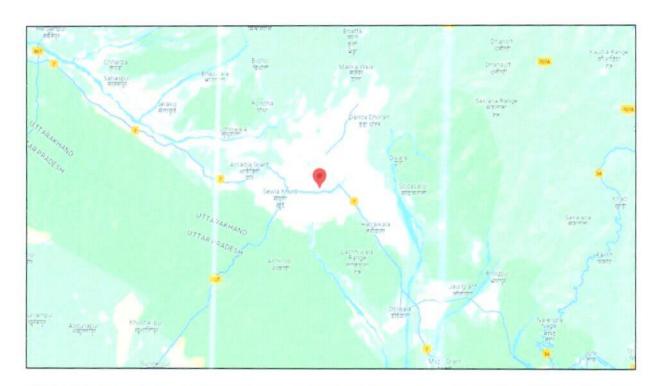
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ENCLOSURE: III - GOOGLE MAP LOCATION



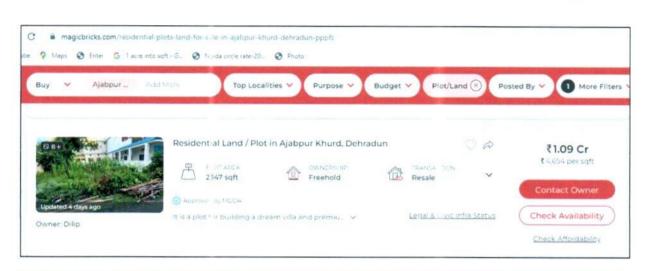


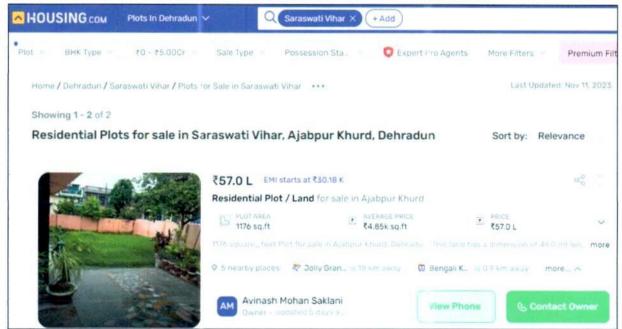

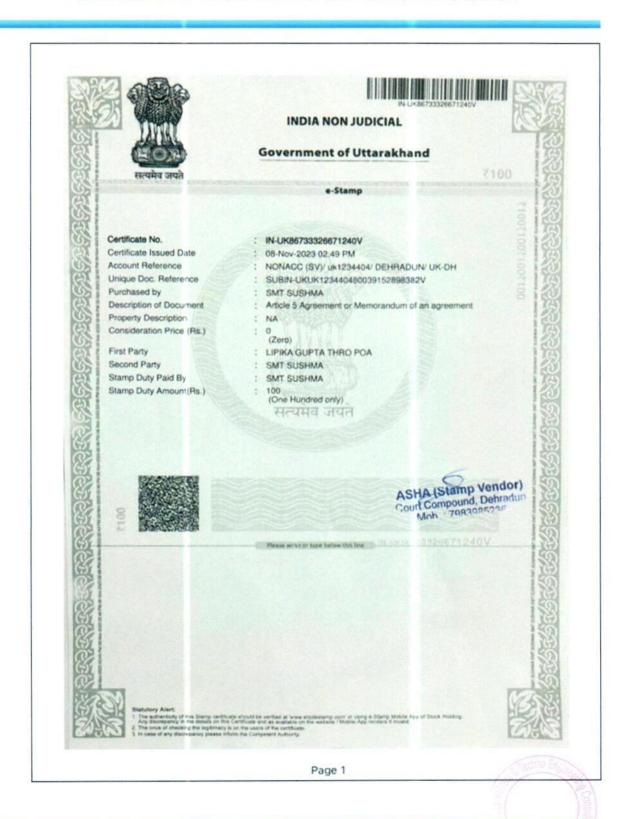

In such event, the party seeking our evidence in the proceedings shall bear the cost/professional fee of attending court / judicial proceedings and my / our tendering evidence before such authority shall be under the applicable laws.
44.	The final copy of the report shall be considered valid only if it is in hard copy on the company's original letter head with proper stamp and sign on it of the authorized official upon payment of the agreed fees. User shall not use the content of the report for the purpose it is prepared for only on draft report, scanned copy, email copy of the report and without payment of the agreed fees. In such a case the report shall be considered as unauthorized and misused.

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
