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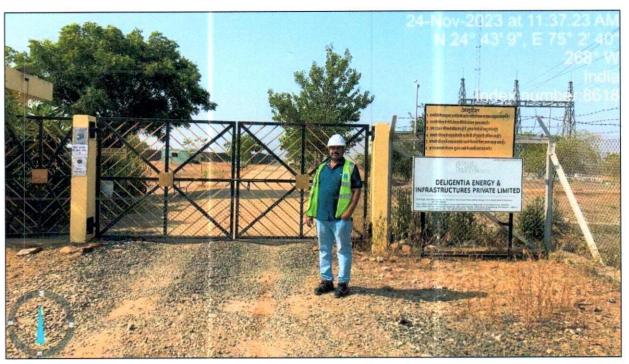

As per revenue records in the year 2003, the said Khasra No. 35, 49 & 48/2 admeasuring about 4,22,800 sq. mtr, 1,47,900 sq. mtr & 9300 sq. mtr. originally belonged to State Government of Madhya Pradesh. Thereafter Collectorate Neemuch , District Neemuch passed its order dated 18.06.2013 for the non-agricultural use of the land was muted in the name of M/s. Deligentia Energy and Infrastructures Pvt. Ltd.

During site survey it is found that land is used as a solar power plant and the property is properly

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demarcated. However, Cizra map is not provided by the client on our request.

The subject property is located in the midst of rural area of Sutholi Village Tehsil Jawad located in the District Neemuch, Madhya Pradesh. The nearby locality is a rural area. Lot of agricultural land is also available in the surrounding.

We are relying on the property that was shown to us by the owner's representative during the survey since the client didn't provide us a copy of the Cizra map. Additionally, the legitimacy of the ownership paperwork is not shown in this valuation assessment

In case of discrepancy in the address mentioned in the property documents and the property shown to us at the site due to change in zoning or administrative level at the site or client misled the valuer by providing the fabricated document, the valuation should be considered of the property shown to us at the site of which the photographs are also attached. Our responsibility will be only related to the valuation of the property shown to us on the site and not regarding matching from the documents or searching the property from our own. Banker to verify from district administration/ tehsil level the identification of the property if it is the same matching with the document pledged.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property found on as-is-where basis on site for which the Bank/ customer has shown & asked us to conduct the Valuation for which photographs is also attached with the report. We have carried out inspection of public records pertaining to the Schedule Property at the (i) Office of the Registrar of Assurances (ii) Office of the Sub-Registrar, (iii) other relevant public offices to be 1-sted out (including Courts, relevant municipal offices, 1 and Acquisition offices etc).

The scope, the key observations and our opinion are as follows:-

1.
