BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This Valuation report is prepared for the residential cum commercial property situated at the aforesaid address. As per the copy of TIR, the subject property is owned by Mr. Saurabh Mittal & Mr. Sandeep Mittal both s/o Mr. Vinod Kumar Mittal having total land area of 898.47 sq.mtr.

The subject property comprises of Basement, Ground, First and Second floor under-construction having total covered area of 1,483.98 sq.mtr / 15,973.56 sq.ft. Since Copy of approved Sanction Plan is not shared with us and during site measurement, the staircase passage has blocked from 1st floor so measurement couldn't be done. Therefore, all the measurement is considered as mentioned in old valuation report provided to us. As per the information gathered on site the subject property is in under construction stage since 2020 and only RCC structure work has completed.

The subject property is situated at House Tax No. 68, Mohalla Rajputana, Pargana & Tehsil Roorkee, Haridwar, Uttarakhand, opposite Anaz Mandi, therefore, all the basic and civic amenities are available within the close proximity of the subject property.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. 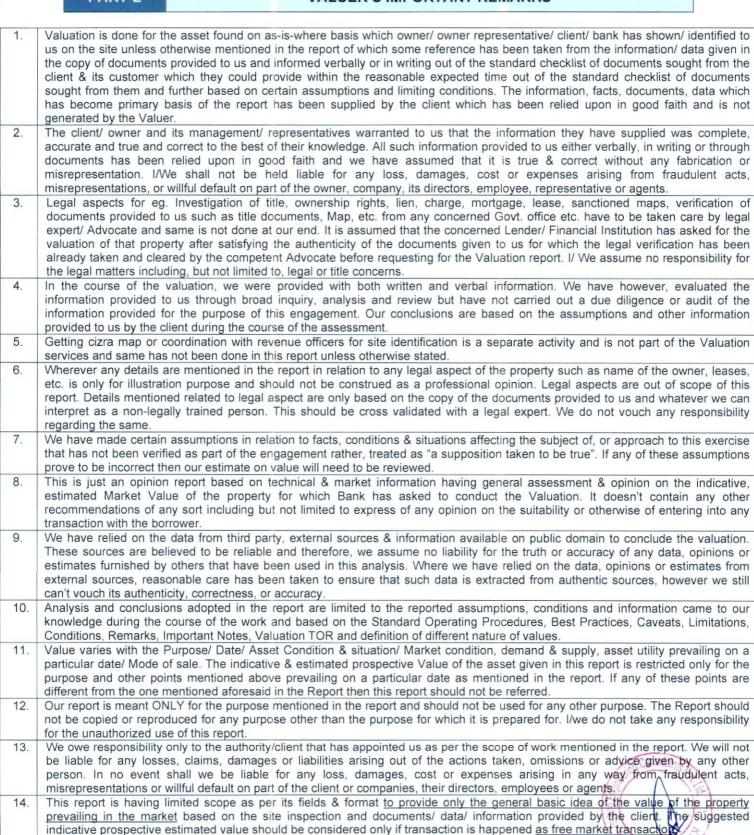
