PART B

INTRODUCTION

1. THE PROJECT:

M/s. JGN Sugar & Biofuels Private Limited is establishing an integrated sugar complex, with the expansion of the current sugar plant from 2,500 TCD to 3,240 TCD and 21.8 MW cogeneration plant in Phase-I, and 3,000 TCD raw syrup plant, 225 KLPD Ethanol processing plant under Phase-II. But, in Phase-I, only the expansion of current sugar plant from 2,500 TCD to 3,240 TCD is carried out and not the 21.8 MW Co- generation plant. The same has been in progress in Phase-II along with other sections as mentioned in Phase-II.

2. PROJECT OVERVIEW:

The scope of the work for this report is limited to the Phase-II which consists of 21.8 MW Cogeneration plant as proposed in Phase-I, 3,000 TCD raw syrup plant and 225 KLPD Ethanol processing plant. Combining all, it will be an integrated sugar complex with the above-mentioned capacities.

The said plant of Kisan Sahakari Chini Mills Limited is a unit of Uttarakhand Sahakari Chini Mills Limited. As per the details received from the company, the Sitarganj Project was commissioned in the year 1984-85 at a capacity of 1,250 TCD. It was later expanded to a capacity of 2,500 TCD in the year 1989-90. Furthermore, the performance of the Sitarganj unit has been steadily declining during the last few years and leading to financial problems. This has happened in particular as the Sitarganj mill is a standalone sugar plant and does not have the backend facilities to manufacture ethanol or availability of surplus power for export.

With the sharp increase in sugarcane prices and in absence of the facilities for manufacture of ethanol and surplus power, the sugar mill has been unable to ensure timely payment of a remunerative sugarcane price thus, discouraging the sugarcane growers in the area to grow sugarcane. This is further accentuated with the bifurcation of the area into Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh. Thus, despite favorable soil and climate and abundant irrigation facilities yet the Sitarganj mill suffered from a very poor capacity utilization, leading to a steep fall in its profitability / economic viability causing economic hardships to the growers in the command area & financial strain on the Uttarakhand exchequer.

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


The Uttarakhand Sahakari Chini Mills Sangh Limited of the Uttarakhand state therefore decided to lease the sugar mill to a concessioner on a long-term basis with the commitment to develop and expand the sugar mill as a sugar complex with backend facilities for manufacture of ethanol and produce surplus power for export, to achieve Techno-Financial viability.

To achieve the above, Expression of Interest (EOI) were invited from eligible parties and after shortlisting the EOIs and protracted discussions and negotiations, the lease of Sitarganj unit has been granted to M/s. JGN Sugar & Biofuels Private Limited (herein after called "Concessioners"), on a mutually agreeable terms and conditions.

JGN Sugar and Biofuels Private Limited (JGN) was incorporated on September 19, 2022 is a consortium of M/s. Bahl Paper Mills Limited (BPML) and Mr. C.K Jain owner of M/s. Gulshan Polyols Ltd (GPL). The company is being formed to install and commence production of sugar, ethanol and co-generation plants on land leased from Uttarakhand Sahakari Chini Mills Sangh Limited on a Develop, Operate, Maintain and Transfer (DOMT) basis.

As per the terms of Agreement, M/s JGN Sugar & Biofuels Pvt Ltd are required to infuse adequate capital to develop the Sitarganj sugar unit into an integrated sugar complex with facilities for manufacture of ethanol and export of surplus power.

PLANT INFRASTRUCTURE SECTIONS & FACILITY DETAILS WITH ACTUAL PROGRESS

1. LAND & SITE DEVELOPMENT:

As per the TEV report provided and as per the discussion with the company, the project land is under a lease of 30 years by M/s. JGN Sugar & Biofuels Private Limited as lessee.

Note: As per the scope of the assignment, we have not undertaken the verification of land ownership in our assessment. However, as per present status based on our site inspection, the actual project land was observed to be in possession of the company since no encroachment was visible on site.

2. BUILDING & STRUCTURAL DETAILS:

- a. The erstwhile Kisan Sahakari Chini Mills Limited which is now been taken over by M/s. JGN Sugar & Biofuels Private Limited on lease was established in the year 1984-85 and has existing buildings for the Sugar Plant which includes Mill area, finished goods godown, necessary residential quarters (A, B, C & D type only), unloading area, crushing area, boiler, centrifuge, bagging section as also shown in the layout plan below marked in grey. Rest of the area shown in the layout plan below is either existing expansion or future expansion.
- b. Layout plan is prepared by EPC contractor M/s ISGEC Heavy Engineering Ltd., Noida.
- c. Copy of map stamped and signed by sub-inspector revenue is provided. Approval of expansion Plan is yet to be obtained from Chief Inspector Factories which will be obtained in due course as per the company.
- d. As per the TEV report provided to us, the proposed project cost under building and civil structures is mentioned as INR 55.90 Crore.
- e. Out of the above proposed cost, total cost incurred as on 31-01-2024 as shown by the company is INR 4.12 Crore. Break-up of the same is annexed in Annexure-1 of the report below. This is just shown for illustration purpose as provided by the company. Verification of Bills or actual transaction to supplier is not done at our end.

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Note: Buildings marked in Grey represents the existing structures and those marked in green and red represents the current and future expansion.

- 1. We have not been provided with the Phase wise and section wise bifurcation of the project cost.
- 2. The building and civil work is being done by the local contractors, the list of the same is mentioned in Part D of the report below.
- Buildings and structure, cost assessment is not done independently by us as it is out of scope of work and same has been referred based on TEV Report.
- 4. Building Plans have not been shared with us only the approved Layout plan is provided.
- 5. Our team has physically verified and inspected the civil work that is currently in progress as enumerated in Table below:



- 2. The foundations of the structures related to raw syrup plant like FFE area and juice clarifier, power house along with panel area, mill house section along with sugar cane carrier, boiler section, fermentation tanks and water reservoir have been completed.

 3. Super structures of mill house, power house, raw syrup plant and fermentation tapks are in the carrier, boile section, fermentation tanks and water reservoir have been completed.

evidence of the works that is currently in progress and provide a clear representation of the
current status of the unit.

3. PLANT MACHINERY & EQUIPMENT:

For the project work related to plant & machinery, the company has appointed M/s. ISGEC Heavy Engineering Limited as a technical consultant and contractor vide copy of Letter of Intents with Ref. Nos. JGN/KSP/2023-24/87, JGN/KSP/2023-24/88, JGN/KSP/2023-24/89 dated 31-07-2023 for the design, manufacture, supply, erection and commissioning of 6000 TCD Milling Plant, 3000 TCD Raw Syrup Plant, 225 KLPD Ethanol Plant on syrup with 120 TPH Boiler and 21.8 MW Cogeneration Plant, and 40 TPH Incineration Boiler and 4.8 MW power plant. The total project cost proposed as mentioned in the LOI is shown in the table below:

Observations and comments:

- The machines have been verified as per the copy of invoices provided to us by the company and also as per the physical verification during the site visit.
- 2. The machines mentioned in the table above are related to the Raw Syrup Plant major machinery being Falling Film Evaporator (FFE). FFE is a combination of three parts bottom, middle and top section. As per the observation during site survey, only 6 Nos. of bottom part is installed out of 9. Remaining 3 bottom parts, and 8 middle parts were present at the site near raw syrup plant for erection. During site survey top section of FFE was also

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present. However same arrived on site in February, therefore has not been considered in this report since report majorly captures the work done upto January as much as clear information we can get from the site.

- 3. Apart from FFE, parts of Juice Clarifier, Rotary Screen, Condenser Bellows, Foundation Bolts & Shim Plates for Syrup plant and carriers were also present at the site for erection.
- 4. Fabrication of tanks for fermentation section is in progress as observed during the site survey.
- 5. Supporting photographs have been attached in the report. These photos serve as visual evidence of the works that is currently in progress and provide a clear representation of the current status of the unit.
- 6. Out of the total project cost under plant & machinery, the total cost incurred as on 31-01-2024 as shown by the company is INR 6.51 Crore. The cost is related to the purchase of the machines as shown arrived on site in the above Plant wise details. Breakup of the same is annexed as Annexure-2 in the report as per the Bills/ invoices made available to us. This is just shown for illustration purpose as provided by the company. Cost assessment is not done independently by us as it is out of scope of work and same has been referred based on TEV Report.

6. Only those invoices are considered for which work is seen on the site.

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





About the Project



- The subject project consists upgrading/setting up of capacities 3,240 TCD for Sugar, 3,000 TCD for production of Raw Sugar Syrup for Ethanol Processing, Distillery Plant of 225 KLPD & 21.8 MW power plant at Sitarganj, Uttarakhand.
- The said plant of Kisan Sahakari Chini Mills Limited is a unit of Uttarakhand Sahakari Chini Mills Limited. As per the details received from the company, the Sitarganj Project was commissioned in the year 1984-85 at a capacity of 1,250 TCD. It was later expanded to a capacity of 2,500 TCD in the year 1989-90. Furthermore, the performance of the Sitarganj unit has been steadily declining during the last few years and leading to financial problems. 

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

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
