## BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for residential plot situated at Kh. No. 333k, Mauja Mohkampur Khurd, Pargana Parwadoon, District Dehradun. All the basic and civic amenities are available within the close proximity of the subject property. As per the copy of sale deed the property is having total land area 196.66 sq.mtr/ 235.20 sq.yds and owned by Mr. Anshu Agarwal. Out of this 196.66 sq.mtr/ 235.20 sq.yds Mr. Dev Singh proposes to purchase 171 sq yd land, as per the agreement to sale provided by bank. It is however noted that the agreement to sale does not have signature of Mr. Anshu Agarwal.

As per site survey the property (portion of land proposed for sale) is partially demarcated with temporary pillars therefore it may be considered as merged with adjoining property. Plot number was also not found mentioned nearby. The property was identified by owner's representative and during site measurement the area was found to be 171 sq.yds. and same is considered for valuation purposes.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the

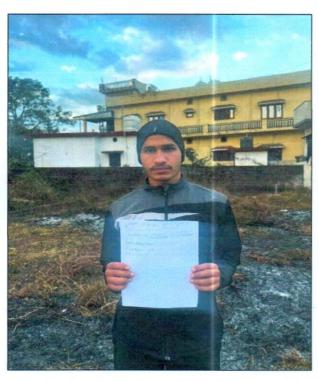

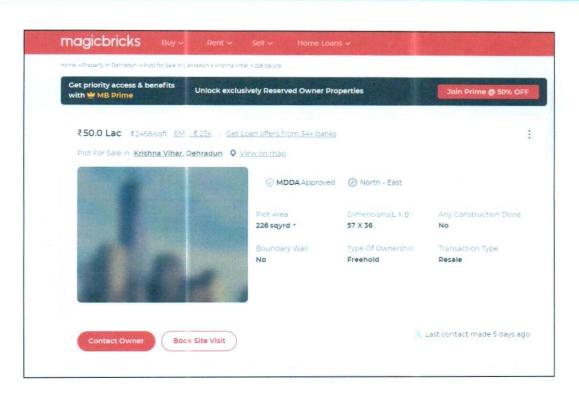

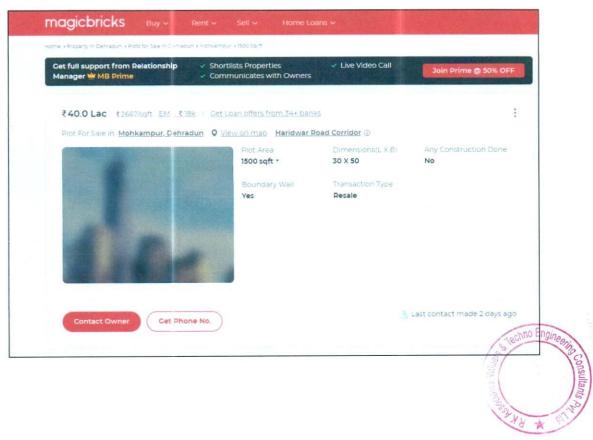
