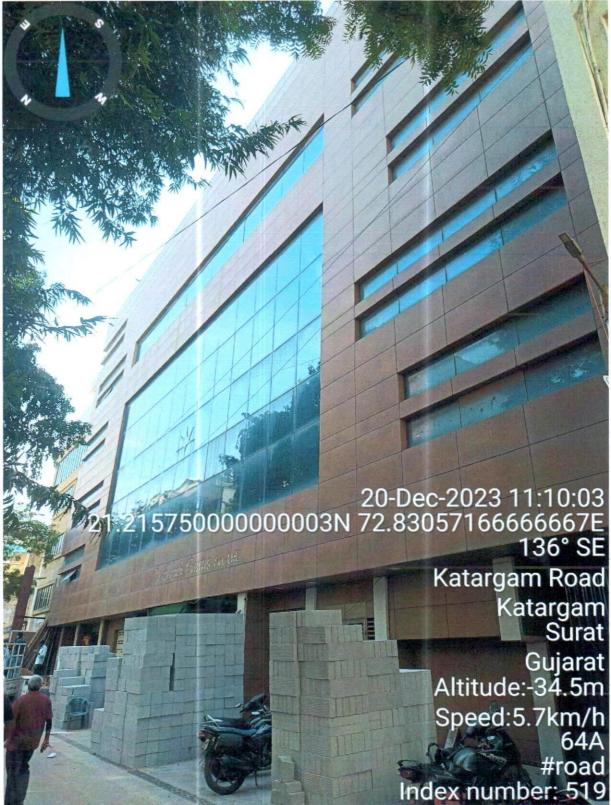

As the purpose of valuation is DRT recovery.

The subject property is intended for commercial use and is strategically positioned adjacent to Katargam road. Access to this property is conveniently facilitated through Surat railway station, situated at a distance of 2 kilometers. The nearest airport, Surat International Airport, is located approximately 12 kilometers away. Furthermore, the property enjoys close proximity to essential amenities.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. 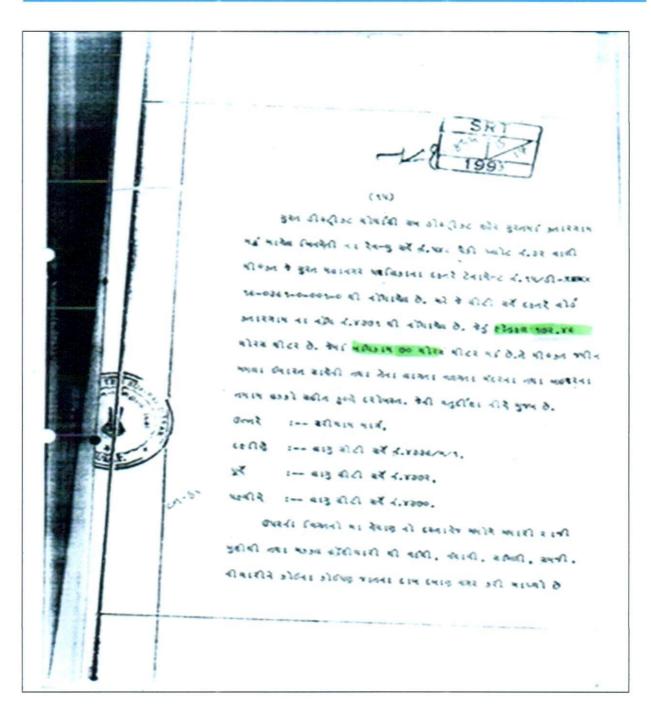

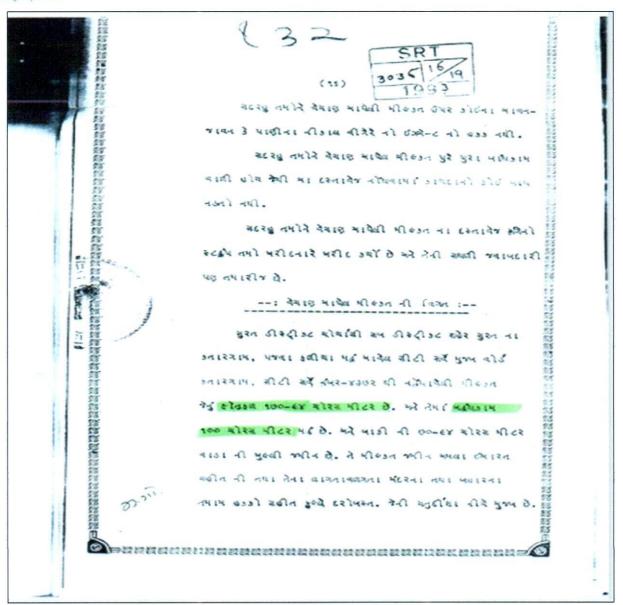

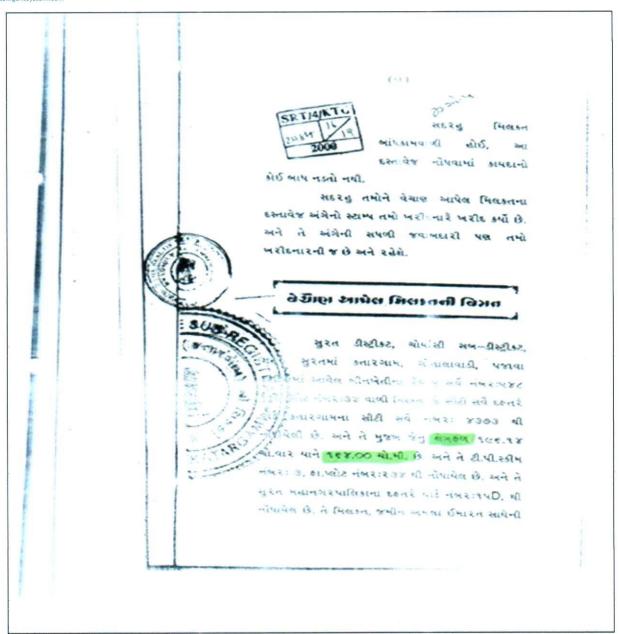

- 8. A valuer shall continuously maintain professional knowledge and skill to provide competent professional service based on up-to-date developments in practice, prevailing regulations/guidelines and techniques.
- 9. #### Information Management

- 21. A valuer shall ensure that he/ it maintains written contemporaneous records for any decision taken, the reasons for taking the decision, and the information and evidence in support of such decision.
