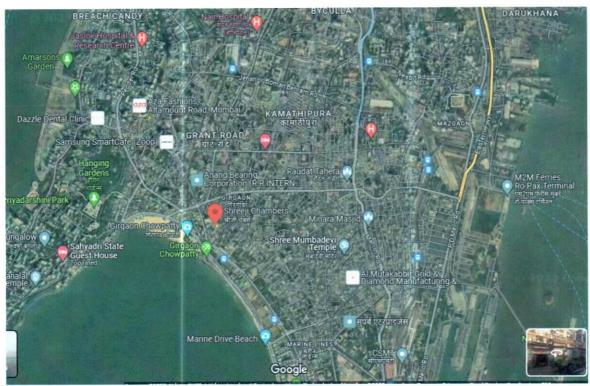

Integrity and Fairness
