

Adopted Rates Justification XXVIII.

As per our discussion with the property dealers and habitants of the subject location we have gathered the following information:-

- There is adequate availability of built up unit (having similar size as our subject property) in the subject locality. However, no space is available in Behala Industrial Estate.
- 2. Rates for built up having size around 3,500 sq. mt., available on subject locality varies within the range of Rs.4,000/- to Rs.6,000/- per sq. ft.
- The allotment rate of commercial space at Behala Industrial Estate is Rs.4,400/- per sq. ft. The screenshot of the same is attached below.



Based on the above information and keeping in mind the adequate availability of built up unit in subject locality we are of the view to adopt a rate of Rs.5,000/per sq. ft. for the purpose of this valuation assessment. The subject property is a leasehold commercial property with a lease period of 3 Years and 3 months starting from 19-05-2022 to 03-08-2025, out of which now only 1.5 years of lease is remaining. Since the property is lease hold and the lessor has allowed to lessee to mortgage only Lease Hold Rights therefore, we have adopted the Profit Rent Capitalization Method for the valuation of the property for the balance lease period.

NOTE: We have taken due care to take the information from reliable sources. The given information above can be independently verified from the provided numbers to know its authenticity. 
