2. PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PROPERTY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

- 19. In any fairness opinion or independent expert opinion submitted by a valuer, if there has been a prior engagement in an unconnected transaction, the valuer shall declare the association with the company during the last five years.

Confidentiality

20. A valuer shall not use or divulge to other clients or any other party any confidential information about the subject company, which has come to his/its knowledge without proper and specific authority or unless there is a legal or professional right or duty to disclose.

Information Management

- 21.
