ACQUISITION OF LANDS.

[G.O. Rt. No. 583, Industries and Commerce,
1st December 1971.]

Under section 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 Central Act I of 1894, the Government of Andhra Pradesh hereby declares that the lands specified below, and measuring 32.96 acres, be the same a little more or less, are needed for a public purpose, to wit, for establishment of Naval Scientific Technological Laboratory and under sections 3 and 7 of the same Act, the Special Tahsildar for Land Acquisition, Revenue Division, Visakhapatnam, is appointed to perform the functions of a Collector under the Act and directed to take order for the acquisition of the said lands. A plan of the lands is kept in the office of the Special Tahsildar for Land Acquisition, Revenue Division, Visakhapatnam and may be inspected at any time during office hours.

Visakhapatnam district, Visakhapatnam taluk,
Butchirajupalem village.

AGREEMENT UNDER SECTION 41 OF THE LAND ACQUISITION ACT, 1894.

[G.O. Rt. No. 588, Industries and Commerce,
2nd December 1971.]

Agreement made the (5th) Fifth day of October, 1971 One thousand nine hundred and seventy one between The Fertilizer Corporation of India Limited a Company deemed to be registered under the Companies Act, 1956, and having its head office at F-43, South Extension Area, Part I, Ring Road, New Delhi-49, hereinafter called "the Company" which term shall mean and include its Administrators, Executors and permitted assigns of the one part AND Governor of Andhra Pradesh, hereinafter called "the Government" which term shall mean and include his successors in office and assigns of the other part;

Whereas upon the application of the Company the Government have agreed to acquire on behalf of the Company under the provisions of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 the pieces or parcels of land described and delineated in the schedule hereto annexed and situated in Jangaon and Maredpak villages, Peddapalli taluk, Karimnagar district, and whereas the Government are satisfied on the report of the officer marking the enquiry under section 40 of the said Act, that the proposed acquisition is needed for the construction of a work likely to prove useful to the public namely Fertilizer Factory and whereas the Government have called upon the Company under section 41 of the said Act, to enter into an agreement with the Government in respect of matters specified in the said section.

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Company shall pay to the Government before the said land is transferred to the Company the cost of the land as settled by the Collector of Karimnagar or if reference is made to the Court, by the final Court of appeal and all costs of the acquisition inclusive of

all payments and allowances in respect thereof payable under the said Act, and all court costs and Pleader's fee etc., incurred by the Government in defending the references, if any made to the Court as aforesaid and on appeal, or appeals filed in connection therewith and all costs, Pleader's fee etc., payable or paid by the Government to the claimants in the said matters. The Government shall not be bound to give possession of the land until all the said moneys have been paid and may withdraw from the acquisition in the event, and in case of such withdrawal, the Company shall be liable to indemnify the Government against all expenses incurred and damage sustained as the result of any thing done by them in the matter or acquisition till the date of withdrawal.

2. Upon such payment by the Company, the Government shall execute and do all such acts, deeds, matters and things as may be necessary or proper for effectively vesting the said land in the Company and giving the Company an absolute title thereto subject to the payment of an assessment or ground-rent as hereinafter provided.

3. The terms upon which the said land shall be held by the Company are:

(a) That the land shall be used for coal based fertilizer factory and its allied purposes or for purposes incidental thereto and for other purposes connected therewith.

(b) That the Company shall pay to the Government annually the appropriate assessment or ground rent as the case may be on the land, which shall be liable to revision at any general revision of the land revenue settlement;

(c) That the Company shall not except with the previous sanction of the Government use the land for any purpose other than that specified above;

(d) That the time within which the land be used for the construction of Coal based Fertilizer Factory and its township or for purposes incidental thereto or and for other purposes connected therewith be completed, shall not exceed 3 years from the date of transfer of the land of the Company;

(e) That where the Government is satisfied after such enquiry as it may deem necessary that the Company was prevented by reasons beyond its control from applying the land for the purposes specified in clauses (a) and (c) above within the time specified in clause, (d), the Government may extend the time for the purpose by a period not exceeding one year at a time, so however that the total period of extension shall not exceed 3 years;

(f) That if the Company commits a breach of any of the conditions provided for in this agreement the Government may make an order declaring the transfer of the land to the Company as null and void whereupon the land shall revert back to the Government, and directing that an amount not exceeding 1/4th of the amount paid by the Company to the Government as the cost of acquisition under clause (1) of section 41 of the said Act shall be forfeited to the Government as damages and the balance shall be refunded to the Company, and the order so made shall be final and binding;

(g) That where there is any dispute with regard to the amount relatable to the un-utilized portion of the land such dispute shall be referred to the Court within whose jurisdiction the land or any part thereof is situated and the decision of the Court shall be final.

(h) Where the Company commits a breach of any of the terms of this agreement the Government shall not make any order under clause (f) or clause (g), unless the Company has been given an opportunity of being heard in the matter;

(i) The Government shall consult the Land Acquisition Committee before according any sanction or exceeding the time or making any order under any of the above clauses;

(j) That in the event of the voluntary relinquishment of the land by the Company as not required, for the purpose for which it was acquired, the Government may resume the land if it is required for a Government or public purpose or if they consider that it should be returned to the original owner. If the Government decide not to exercise this power and inform the Company accordingly, the latter may dispose off the land in any manner it likes. In the event of resumption of the land under this condition the compensation payable to the Company shall be the value of the land at the time of acquisition (less the 15 per cent award for compulsory acquisition) or its value at the time of resumption whichever may be less together with the value of the buildings and other improvements at the time of resumption. If there are buildings on the land which the Government do not require the Company shall remove them at its cost;

4. This agreement shall have effect subject to provisions of the Land Acquisition (Companies) Rules, 1963.

5. All the costs and expenses of and incidental to the preparation and execution of this agreement (including stamp duty and costs of registration, if registration be required by the Government) shall be paid to the Company.
