2. PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PROPERTY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This Valuation report is prepared for the residential property situated at the aforesaid address. As per the copy of gift deed the subject property has land area of 1041.06 sq.mtr. & Built-up area admeasuring 12,175 sq.ft / 1,131 sq.mtr.

During the site survey, it was observed that the subject property is utilized for residential purposes and consists of a structure comprising a ground floor, first floor, and a terrace covered by a tin shed. Notably, only the RCC structure is considered in the building sheet.

Floor-wise description is as follows:

The subject property is located 150 mtr from Gandhi road. The property can be reached from Dehradun railway station, which is at a distance of 1 kilometers from the property. The nearest airport Jolly Grant Airport,

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is located approximately 27 kilometers away. Furthermore, the property enjoys close proximity to essential amenities.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report.
