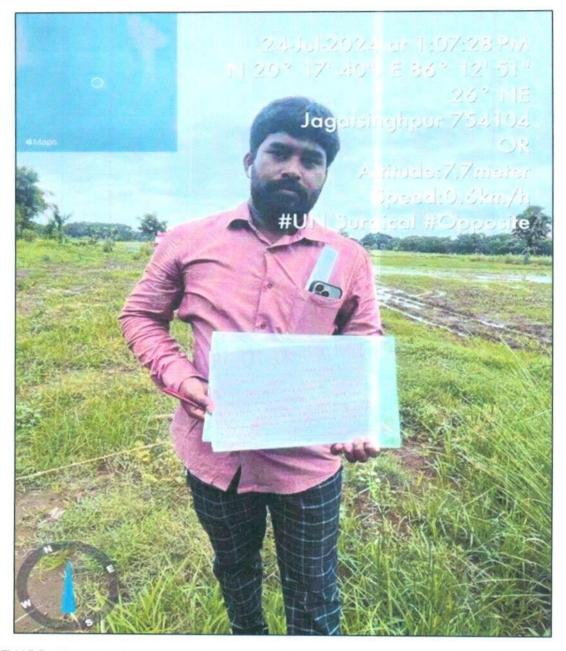

However, we have considered the land area falls under Plot Nos. 1850, 1850/3842, 1846, 1861, 1855, 1860, 1847, 1854 & 1862 (Green highlighted row in the chart given above) for which bank has shared work order. The total area falls under the above mentioned plot nos. is 1.08 Acres / 108 Decimals, which are highlighted in above table for which valuation has been done. We have measured the considered land parcels via google tools on site as per the knowledge of the representative available from client's end, as shown below.



We have done this valuation assignment, considering the land as per its present category. The land area of 0.25 Acres, falls under one affidavit is already converted to non-agricultural (plot nos. – 1846, 1850/3842 & 1847), so we have considered the same as non-agricultural. Another affidavit of remaining land area of 0.83 acres is not yet converted to non-agricultural, as on date. The company has applied to the concerned authority for the conversion of the remaining land parcel (plot nos. – 1855, 1850, 1861, 1854, 1862 & 1860), as per affidavit shared with us dated – 13/08/2024. However, we have assumed the remaining land parcel of 0.83 acres as agricultural (un-cultivated), since it is not converted to non-agricultural as on date.

During site survey it was observed that the land is below from the road level and traces of water logging is visible. The subject property is not demarcated by boundary wall and may be merged with adjoining land parcels.

This report only contains general assessment & opinion on the Guideline Value and the indicative, estimated Market Value of the property of which Bank/ customer asked us to conduct the Valuation for the property found on as-is-where basis as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report. No legal aspects in terms of ownership or any other legal aspect is taken into consideration. Even if any such information is mentioned in the report it is only referred from the information provided for which we do not assume any responsibility. Due care has been given while doing valuation assessment, but it doesn't contain any due-diligence or audit or verification of any kind other than the valuation computation of the property shown to us on site.
