

2. PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PROPERTY

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

This opinion on Valuation report is prepared for the property situated at the aforesaid address. As per the copy of sale deeds the subject property having area of 5,312.20 sq.mtr. However as per the survey, is found that only 1036.47 Sqmtr land is vacant and demarcated with ~4 feet high boundary wall from three side and fourth side is blocked with residential building. Balance area i.e 4275.73 Sq.mtr is covered with single and double storied structures, being used as Tabela for animal and other residential purpose and can be assumed as encroachment. However as per agreement to sale dt 20.12.2007 property is having 183 tenanted structures. Detail of tenants, although stated in the deed is as given as appendix, however nothing found in the given document. Also, it is not clear whether all the structures are occupied and paying rents to the owner. Therefore, value of vacant land has been worked out considering the present status of the property.

Valuation is conducted of the property as shown on the site by the Bank/ customer of which photographs is also attached with the report and same is to be considered in this report irrespective of any details taken from any documents which might have been updated, changed or incorrect.







Hence before financing, Banker/ FI should take into consideration all such future risk and should loan conservatively to keep the advanced money safe in case of the downward trend of the property value. Valuation of the same asset/ property can fetch different values under different circumstances & situations. For eg. Valuation of a running/ operational shop/ hotel/ factory will fetch better value and in case of closed shop/ hotel/ factory it will have considerable lower value.
