## 2. PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE PROPERTY

### BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE PROPERTY UNDER VALUATION

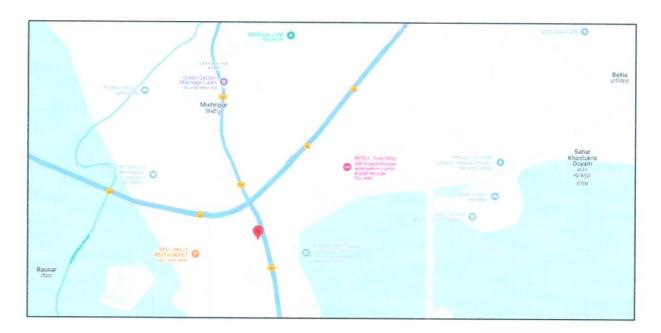

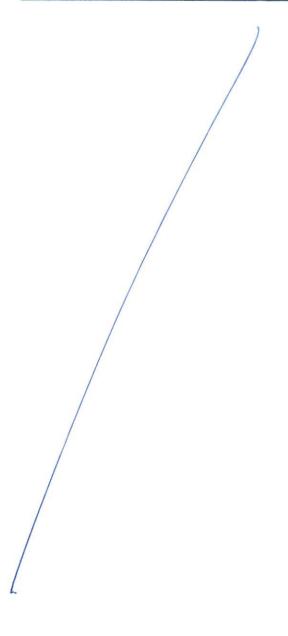

### Integrity and Fairness
