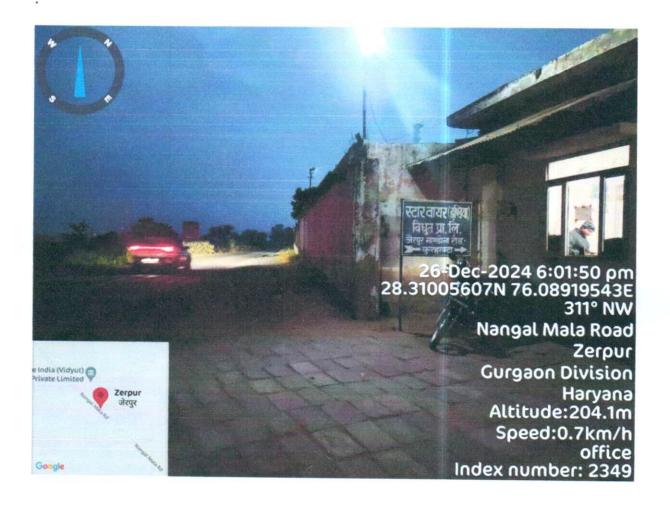

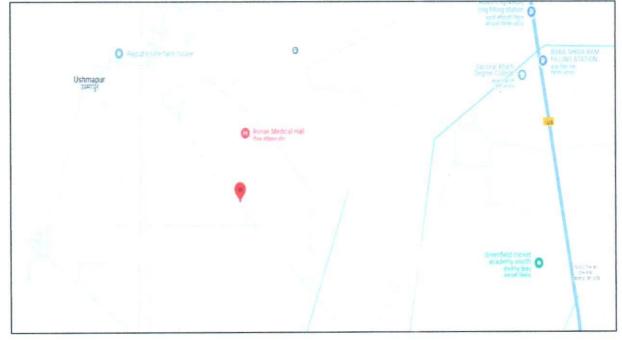

ENCLOSURE: I - GOOGLE MAP LOCATION



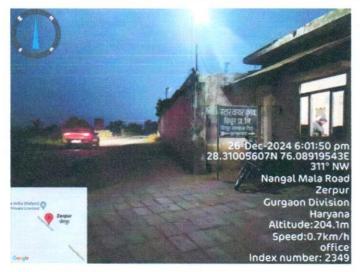




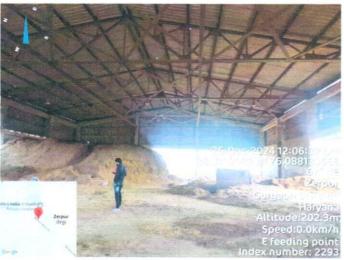
